WHAT IS A PSYCHIATRIST?

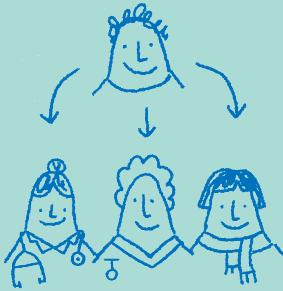
Psychiatrists are specialist medical doctors who are experts in mental health.
